COVID-19: Keeping You Safe

What you can do to stay safe and healthy:



Pay attention to possible symptoms

- Fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, or runny nose may be signs of COVID-19.
- Call your care team as soon as possible if you have any of these.



Come to your scheduled dialysis treatments

- Making all your treatments helps keep you healthy and out of the hospital.
- Even if you have COVID-19, your care team will help you treat safely while protecting others.



Wear a medical mask

- When you're not feeling well or test positive for COVID-19.
- During access-related care activities, such as CVC treatment or PD catheter connections.
- In other situations as determined by your care team.



Get vaccinated and boosted

- Vaccines are the best way to protect against serious illness and hospitalization from COVID-19.
- Your DaVita care team can help get you one.

How we're helping to keep you safe:

- DaVita follows strict guidelines from the CDC and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) to help ensure all patients and care teams stay safe.
- Patients who test positive for COVID-19 may receive dialysis separately from other patients. This could mean they treat at a different time or space.
- DaVita care team members are experts in infection control. They are taking extra precautions to help keep you safe.
